When It's Necessary (The "Fast Track")

If you are under a tight deadline or if design isn't your strongest suit, Starter Templates are a lifesaver.

- **Consistency:** They ensure that your padding, margins, and typography are professional right from the start.
- **Efficiency:** You get a full site structure in minutes, allowing you to focus on the content.
- **Learning Tool:** For students, importing a template is a great way to see how professional developers structure their Elementor sections.

When to Skip It (The "Developer's Path")

As you grow your skills in HTML, CSS, and JavaScript, you might find that Starter Templates feel "heavy" or restrictive.

- **Bloat Control:** Templates often import extra plugins or CSS you don't need. Building from scratch ensures your code is Clean And Fast.



- **Unique Identity:** To make anyablinc.com truly unique, building from a blank canvas allows for total creative control without being boxed into a pre-made layout.
- **Performance:** A "From Scratch" build is often lighter, which helps with your Google search rankings (SEO).
